AGREEMENT FOR ACADEMIC EXCHANGE

The University of Engineering and Management, India (UEM), the Institute of Engineering and Management, India (IEM) and Graduate School of Software and Information Science, Iwate Prefectural University, Japan (GSSIS) conclude this agreement for the purpose of deepening friendships and for extending cooperation in education and research at both schools.

- Article 1. UEM, IEM and GSSIS form this cooperation for the purposes of developing international educational opportunities for students and for the promotion of research activities on the part of faculty members.
- Article 2. This cooperation relates to the following activities, and the details of its implementation shall be discussed and mutually agreed by each institution.
 - 1) Exchange of students and faculty members for lecturing, studies and research.
 - 2) Exchange of information and publications.
 - 3) Other activities of mutual interest.
- Article 3. This agreement becomes effective from the date of signatures by the Deans and the Presidents (or Head) of each institution.
- Article 4. This agreement is valid for 5 years. Its period of validity may be extended by mutual written agreement in written. Either party may, by giving six months' advance written notice to the other institution, terminate this agreement.

Article 5. This agreement can be revised by mutual written consent.

A copy of the Agreement will be retained in each institution.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR STUDENT EXCHANGE

Between



University of Engineering and Management, India Institute of Engineering and Management, India,



And

Graduate School of Software and Information Science, Iwate Prefectural University, Japan

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into, by and between the University of Engineering and Management, India (UEM), the Institute of Engineering and Management, India (IEM) and the Graduate School of Software and Information Science, Iwate Prefectural University, Japan (GSSIS). The MOU is based on the Agreement for Academic Exchange (hereafter referred to as the Agreement) concluded on March 29, 2016.

- 1. The selection and acceptance of exchange students will be carried out according to the code of the host institution.
- 2. Each institution will send up to 3 students each year, and in principle the period of stay will not exceed one year.
- 3. Exchange students will be treated as "Special Research Students" at GSSIS, and as "Visiting Students" at UEM and IEM.
- 4. Exchange students must comply with the code of conduct and all other rules of the host Institution.
- 5. The host institution will not collect entrance examination fees, entrance fees, or tuition.
- 6. Exchange students will be financially responsible for all personal costs, including travel expenses. Low cost accommodation will be arranged by host institute according to availability.
- 7. Each institution will endeavor to accept credits gained by exchange students at host institutions as per discussion and agreement between the PoCs (Point of Contacts).
- 8. The host institution will provide all necessary support required for exchange students, such as visa acquisition.
- 9. Details not listed in this MOU will be established through the deliberation of each institutions if required.
- 10. This MOU becomes effective from the date of signatures by the Deans and the Presidents of each institution.
- 11. This MOU is effective for the period of 5 years and can be renewed by mutual written consent. Within the effective period, this MOU may be terminated by either party provided one month written notice is given to the other party.

- 12. This MOU can be revised by mutual written consent.
- 13. This MOU will automatically expire when the Agreement expires. However, students studying at either institution at the time of expiration can continue until the end of their originally planned period of study.
 - A copy of this MOU will be retained in each institution.
