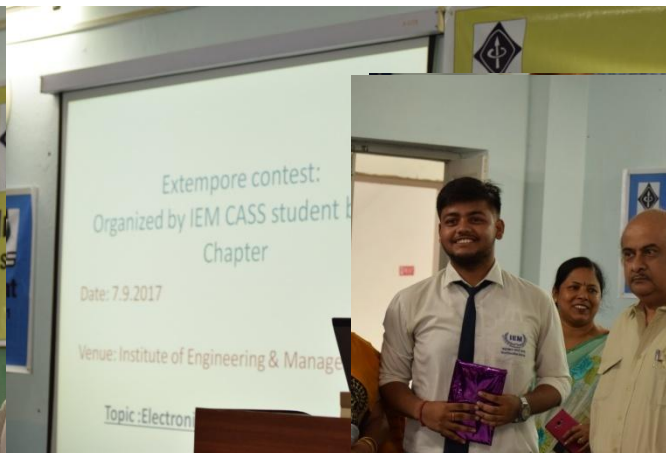
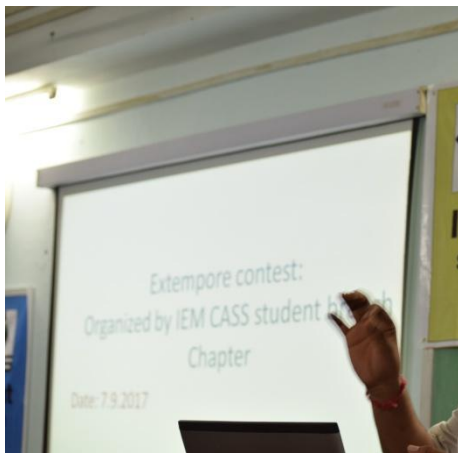

1) Guest Lecture on Nanotechnology (February)

On 28th February 2020, Prof. S. K .Bandhopadhyay of VECC delivered a lecture on Nanotechnology at IEM Gurukul Campus at 4:00 PM. 3) Online Workshop on PCB Designing (April)

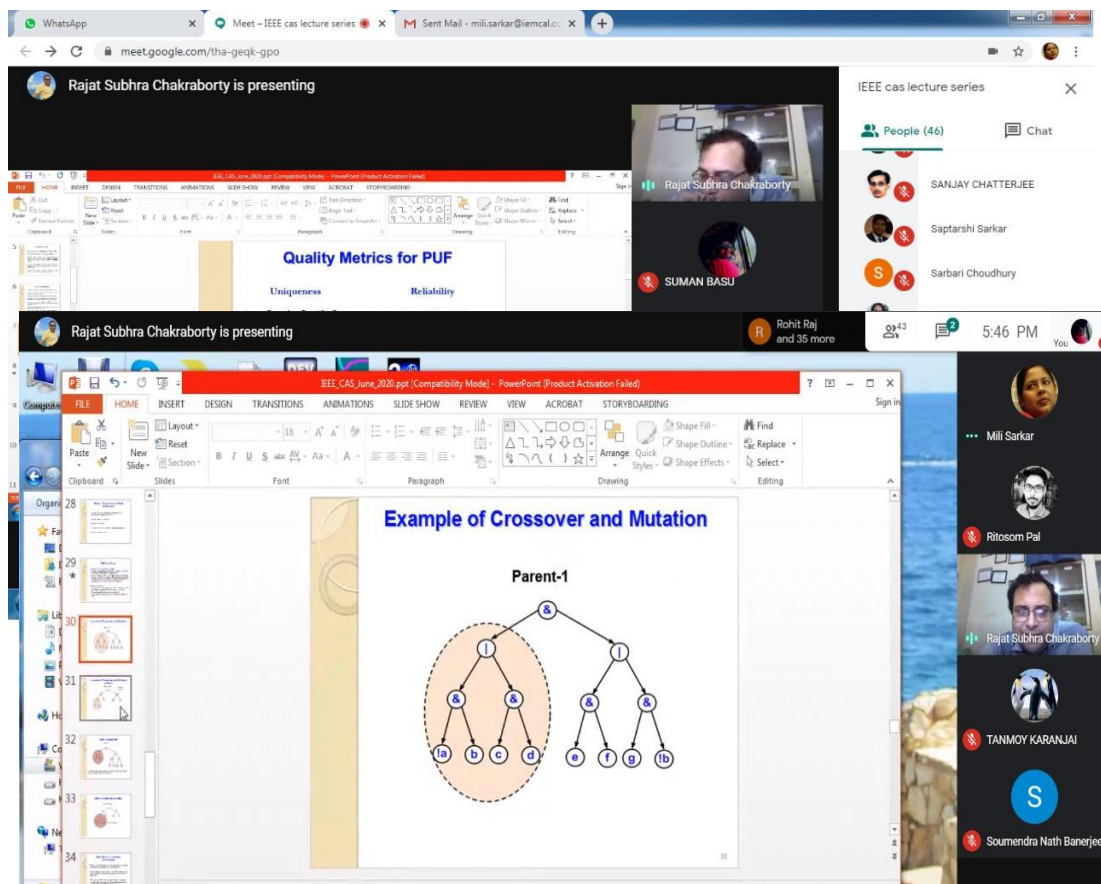

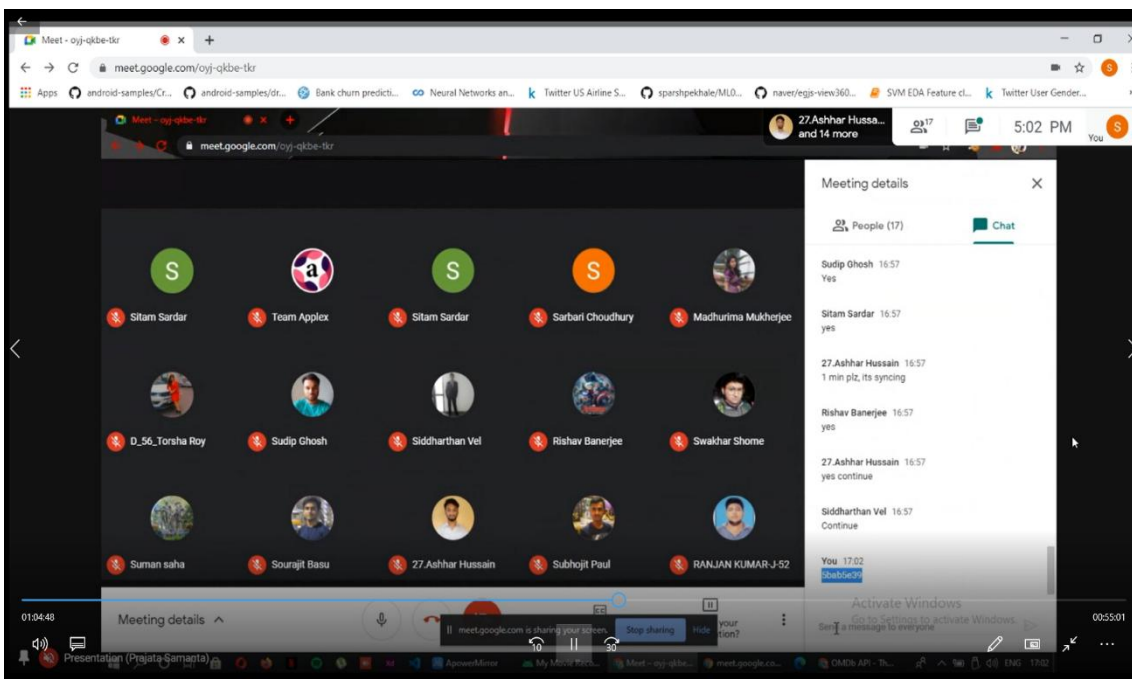
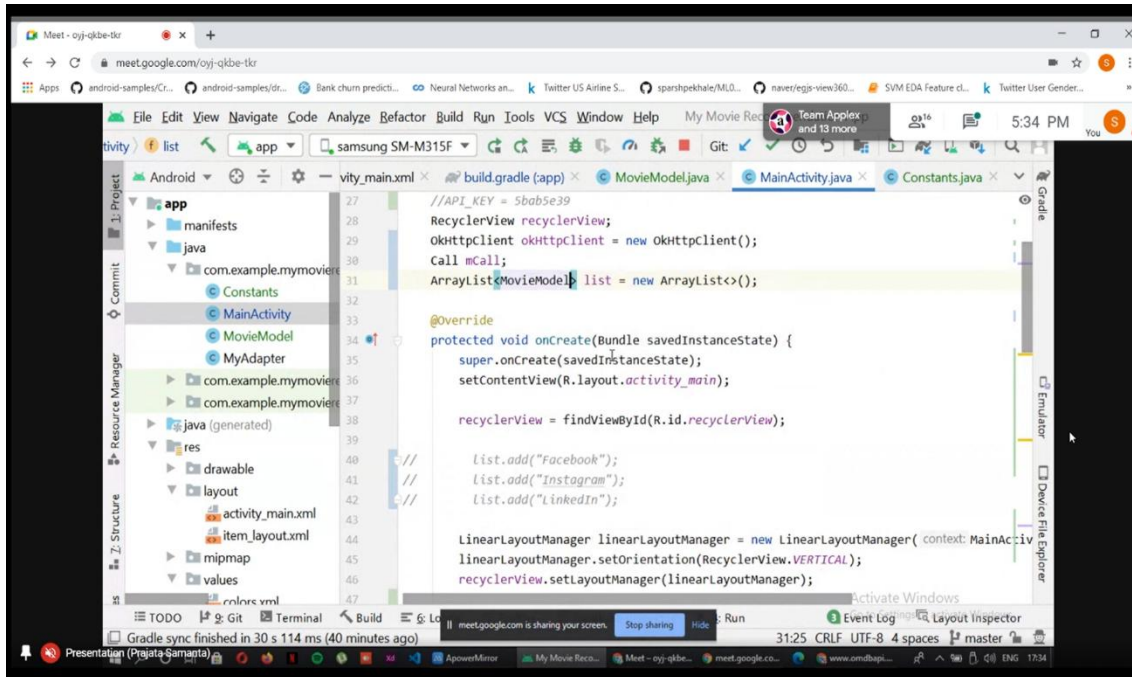
7) Online Interaction Session on Scope of Higher Studies in Quantum Computing (November)
